What the ECO certification logo represents

ECO certified hotels must comply with a detailed set of criteria designed to improve their environmental performance. The following are some of the compulsory criteria met by hotels displaying this logo.

- The management has a written sustainability policy and monitors its environmental goals.*
- The employees receive training on environmental good practice whilst hotel guests are encouraged to participate in specific environmental initiatives.*
- The hotel practises waste separation for recycling purposes.*
- The hotel is using biodegradable cleaning products.*
- At least 50% of all light bulbs in rooms and public areas are energy efficient.*
- The hotel collects rain water and implements a water saving policy.*
- At least 75% of the main foodstuffs used are locally produced.*
